

Amazing Grace #6: “A Story of Grace”

Memory Verse: *Now you, brothers and sisters, like Isaac, are children of promise. (Gal. 4:28 NIV).*

Bible Study:

1. Between Abraham’s two sons what does Paul say is the difference in their origins? Hint: “slave woman...born according to_____”. The other son?
2. Since Paul is using these two sons figuratively, what does he say they represent?
3. What does God instruct the barren woman to do?
4. What promise does God give the desolate? (Is. 54)

Life Application Discussion:

1. Discuss areas where we have been in bondage to the “Law” in our lives as Christians. Recount church experiences where we have felt religious bondage.
2. Share with the group areas where [our own self-imposed] Law “persecuted” our freedom in Christ.
3. How will we change our Christian walk to reflect our newfound freedom in Christ?
