What Now? Application time:**

1. What does it mean to enter the “Most Holy Place” to us in New Testament times? How can we experience this truth more often?

**Summary:** *the Old Testament foreshadowed the New Testament model of blood sacrifice. In the O.T. God gave Moses the design of a Tabernacle, which allowed entrance into God’s Presence by blood. He described the Tent and its contents, the priesthood, the sacrifices, and lay out exactly how the Israelites were to receive forgiveness from sin that separated the people from God. However, this process of cleansing had to be repeated year after year because the blood of animals was not eternal. Jesus comes as a “Priest Forever”, offers Himself as the ultimate sacrifice, and settles once and for all our salvation. The Law and its animal sacrifices could not deal adequately with a guilty conscience. God the Father took the paintbrush of the Eternal Spirit and dipped in it the Blood of Jesus Christ and painted on the canvas of our hearts and minds the words, “NOT GUILTY”. So we are not looking for Jesus to come again to cleanse us from our sins. We anticipate His second coming to consummate His plan of salvation by the complete redemption of our bodies through the final Resurrection.*
